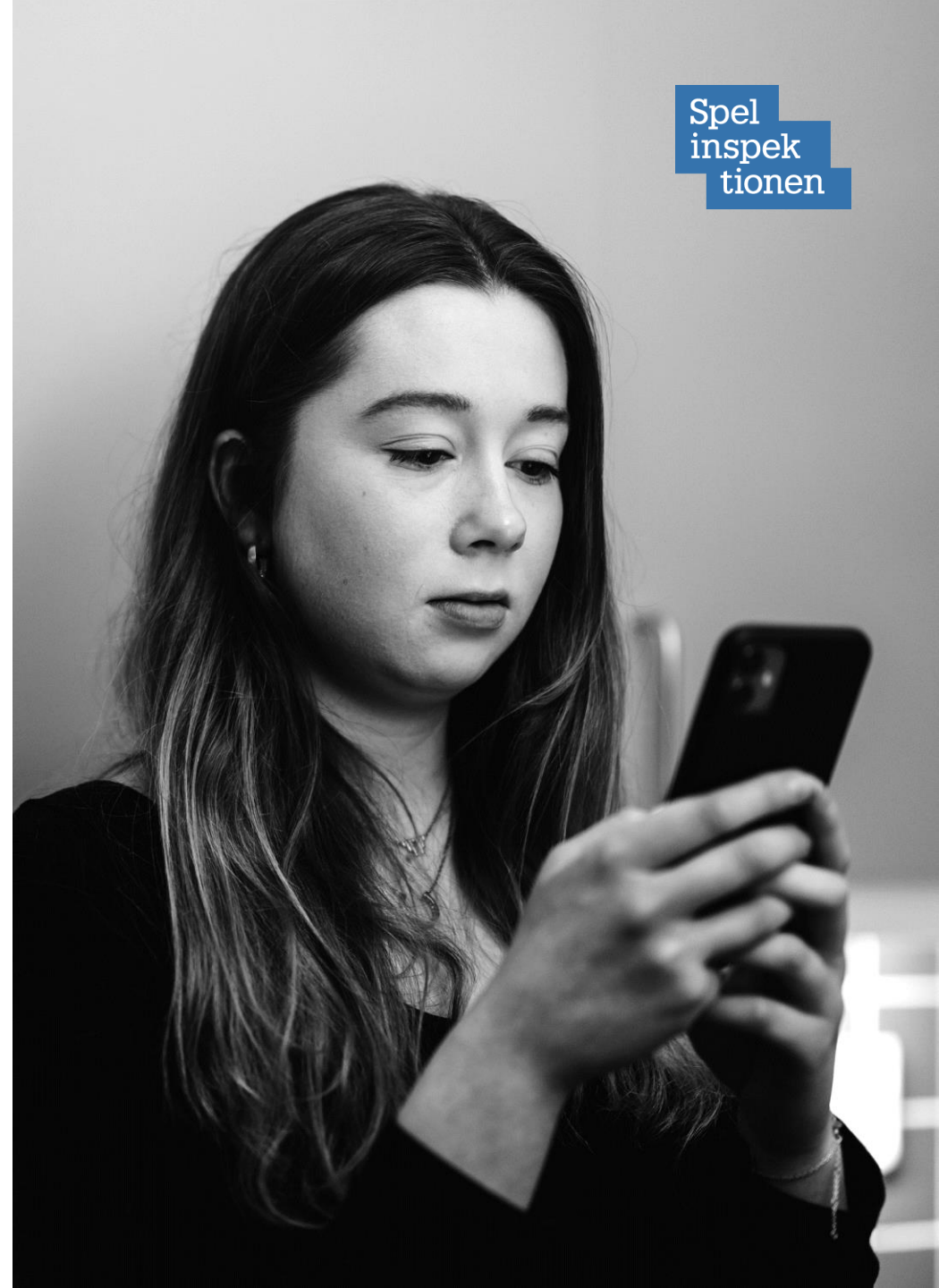

# How gambling is financed

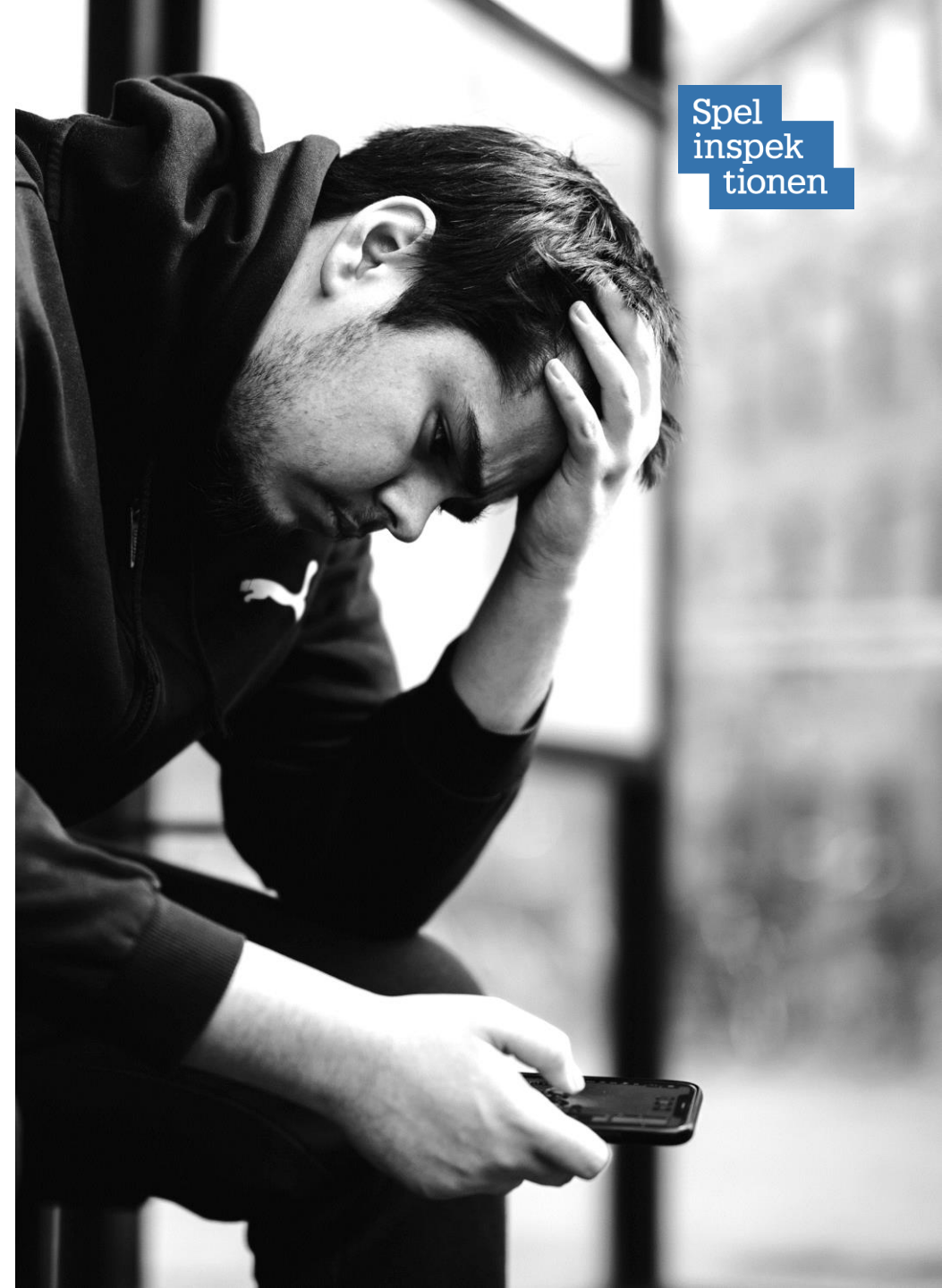
Young adults mainly finance their gambling with student grants or salary.

Loans are more common among young adults with risky gambling.



# Following up young people's gambling

- Gambling by minors is increasing, mainly boys (CAN).
- It is common for young adults to have multiple gambling accounts, especially among those who have risky gambling.
- Increased help-seeking among young adults
